

Police Advice: How to Prevent Theft from your Trade Show Booth

- Carry only what you need for the day and never leave your booth unattended.
- Watch your valuables and keep them close to you, if possible on the front of your body.
- Place valuables out of sight and hide them in the clothing you're wearing.
- Carry handbags and shoulder bags with the opening towards your body.
- Prevent unauthorized access to your private rooms, business premises and lounges, but don't endanger yourself
- A lot of confidence men/women work in teams and collaborate with each other: for example, while one of the thieves distracts a person, an accomplice will steal from them.
- Watch out for confidence teams. Trust your gut instincts.
- If you see any suspicious activity or suspects- always alert law enforcement.
- After hours, remove your valuables from the trade show display and lock them up.

Have you been robbed?

- File a police report.
- You can report a lost or stolen card by dialing 116116.
- Find your mobile phone's serial number (IMEI number) by dialing *#06# on the keypad. Details about your device's IMEI or serial number will automatically appear on the screen. If your phone is stolen you should report it to the police. Law enforcement might request the serial number of your device.
